### **EXPLANATION OF SPECIAL DAYS ON OCTOBER CALENDAR**

**Traffic Safety Assembly:** (Oct. 7) A state policeman will be visiting our school with information for our students about being safe when in a moving vehicle. There will be three different assemblies. The first will be for our elementary classes. He will cover different subjects and focus on buckling up. The second assembly will be for those students who are specifically at driving age. They will discuss many different hazards of teen age driving. The third assembly will be for seventh through twelfth grade and will cover such topics as responsibilities of riding with another teenager.

**PSAT TEST:** (Oct. 12) All eleventh graders are required to take this test. It will be important for them to get a good night's sleep as well as a hearty breakfast. Test fees will need to be paid before the test day. PSAT scores open up different opportunities for scholarships.

**DRESS UP DAY:** (Oct. 18) We will have a special fun day for all students who would like to participate. Students can dress up like their favorite cartoon character, Bible character, Historical character, or animal.
